Programme

Competition No.1 – 4 year old horses - biathlon.

Dressage test and jumping course with obstacles up to 105 cm. (Art.238.1.1.). Competition evaluating horse's movement.

Competition No.2 – 5 year old horses – biathlon.

Dressage test and jumping course with obstacles up to 110 cm. (Art. 238.1.1.). .). Competition evaluating horse's movement.

Competition No. 3 – Amateur class – biathlon.

Dressage test and jumping obstacles up to 110 cm. (Art. 238.2.1.).

Prize giving ceremony

5 best riders of each competition will be awarded with money prizes, diplomas and ribbons. LHBA champion title for young horses is awarded by adding up points accumulated in dressage test and jumping course. The breeder of best young horse will be awarded as well.

Entry fee

Competitions No.1 and No.2 – no entry fee

Competition No. 3 – 5 Ls per entry

Entry fee must be paid no later than 30 minutes prior to the competition.

The organising committee authorizes the chief of jury not to invite to start riders who have not fulfilled their financial obligations.

Special conditions

Competition begins with a dressage test in a dressage arena. If the participant qualifies, they are given 20-25 minutes to warm up for jumping course.

Adjudication in dressage – the test is evaluated by 2 judges.

Adjudication in jumping – the participant is evaluated by 3 judges. After the invitation of the chief of jury all judges show their marks for the participant.

To determine the champion, the score for dressage test and jumping course are summed.

Foreign participants are allowed, but they cannot compete for the champion title.

Martingales and protective legwear for horses is prohibited for the dressage test. Horse's mane must be braided.
